- Job Title:** Junior Docent - Los Serenos de Point Vicente
- Objective:**
- * Greet visitors at Point Vicente Interpretive Center (PVIC)
 - * Guide tours through the PVIC exhibits
 - * Assist with Whale of a Day and special events
 - * Participate in docent-led public hikes
- Qualifications:**
- * Be able to volunteer at least 3-4 hours a month (during school year)
 - * Be interested in learning new skills and information
 - * Enjoy working with children and adults
- Responsibilities:** and during
- * Assist Docents at PVIC, at WOAD and on public hikes on weekends summer break
 - * Attend special educational and administrative meetings
 - * Serve a minimum of 36 hours each year
- Job Training:**
- The class meets an average of three hours, once a week for 7 weeks. Training consists of both classroom instruction, guided tours and field trips.
- Requirements:**
- * Provide recommendation from a school teacher or counselor
 - * Complete an interview process
 - * Complete training program
 - * Attend at least one Public Hike during the training period
 - * Agree to a 15-month commitment after completion of training program
- Cost:** There is a \$20.00 fee for class materials due at the start of the program.
